The word “Ararat” is cited four times in the Bible. The most famous biblical passage involving Ararat is found in the book Genesis and involves the Flood descriptions that hist Earth during Noah’s time. According to the biblical text (Gen. 8:4), it was in the mountains of Ararat where Noah’s Ark rested after the waters of the Flood subsided, and then, there, humanity started a new beginning.

A New Beginning

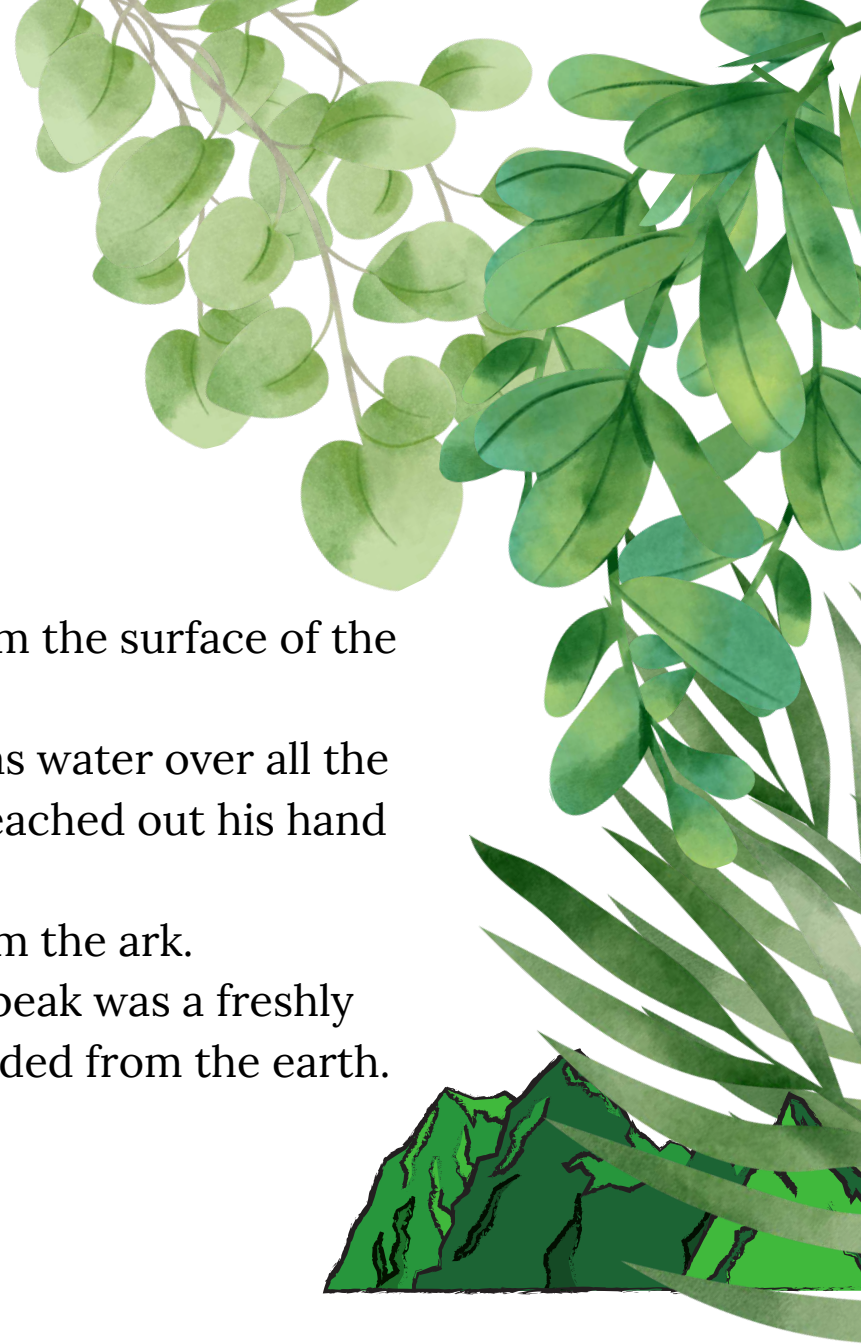
⁸ Then he sent out a dove to see if the water had receded from the surface of the ground.

Motivations

The implementation of Ararat Safe Harbor, a shelter for women and children victims of human trafficking violence, domestic violence and sexual abuse and exploitation of children, whose proposals are:

- To protect women, children, and adolescents and prevent the continuation of situations of domestic violence and human trafficking;
- To provide an environment of physical and emotional safety while strengthening the victim's self-esteem;
- To identify situations of violence, concealed or reported, and their causes to fully expand the concept of sheltering women and children;

- To enable them to build personal projects aimed at overcoming the cycle of violence;
- To provide them with the development of skills and opportunities to develop their personal and social autonomy;



- To promote the access to a professional qualification and requalification network aimed towards productive inclusion;
- To propose a new model of shelter that changes the standard of institutional shelters in the city, in the State and in the Country;
